Kopenhagen Prozess

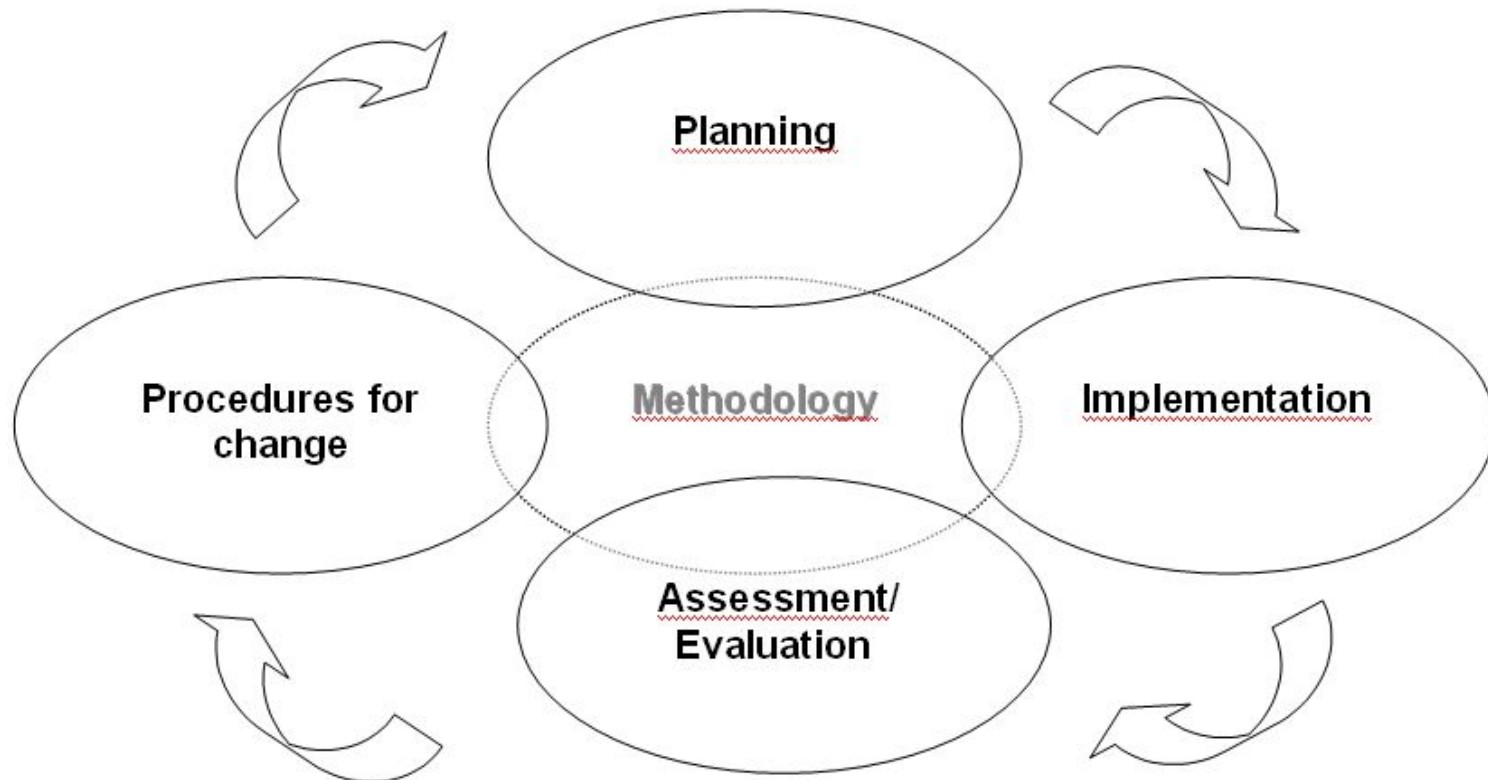
The “VET-Package”:

- Single framework for the transparency of qualifications and competences (EQF)
- System of credit transfer in VET (ECVET)
- Mandate to develop a framework for quality assurance in VET (EQARF)

The Education Council Conclusions (5/2004)

- CQAF auf freiwilliger Basis verbreiten und anwenden
- Entwicklung von praktischen Initiativen zur Ermittlung des “added value” für die Verbesserung nationaler oder regionaler Systeme



EQARF

- Empfehlung des Europäischen Parlaments und des Rates zur Einrichtung eines:
European **Q**uality **A**ssurance **R**eference **F**ramework for VET
- Status: derzeit im sog. co-decision process, Beschlussfassung 2009
